### **Before Reading:**

Thoroughly orientate the readers to the story. This vital step is about setting students up for early success.

	Introduce Book – This book is called <i>Dress-Up Day</i>
	This book is about what you might find in a dress-up box
	Preview Text – discuss and predict using Teacher Talk introduction to activate prior knowledge. "Do you like dressing up in funny clothes? Look at all the costumes in the dressing-up box. Which costume would you like to wear?"
	Introduce Focus Letters: Dd Ff Jj Kk Ll Pp Qq Ss
	Take students on a picture walk through the book to introduce any unfamiliar or new concepts; Example: in <i>Dress-up Day</i> – Do the children have a dress-up box? What do they have in their dress- up box that isn't in the book?

Use Teacher Talk to stimulate discussion about topic

### **During Reading:**

- □ Notice letters in isolation and at the start of the words.
- Use initial letter plus picture clues to read unknown words.
- Understand use of punctuation marked in red.


### After Reading:

- Learn Focus Letters using flashcards (back cover)
- □ Identify each letter by sound and by name
- □ Match upper and lower case letters (divide flashcards)
- Promote drama, writing, or art, as creative follow-up activities.
